Clear Channel Outdoor Holdings, Inc. ("CCOH") is an indirect, non-wholly owned subsidiary of Clear Channel Communications, Inc. ("CCU"), which is a wholly owned subsidiary of Clear Channel Capital I, LLC. Consistent with its previous disclosure, on August 11, 2014, CCOH (i) demanded repayment of \$175 million outstanding under that certain Revolving Promissory Note (the "Due from CCU Note") dated November 10, 2005 (as amended by the First Amendment entered into on December 23, 2009 and the Second Amendment entered into on October 23, 2013) between CCU, as maker, and CCOH, as payee, and (ii) concurrently paid a special cash dividend in an aggregate amount equal to \$175 million (or \$0.4865 per share) to its Class A and Class B stockholders of record at the close of business on August 4, 2014, including Clear Channel Holdings, Inc., an indirect subsidiary of CC Media Holdings, Inc., the parent company of CCU and CCOH ("CCMH"), and CC Finco, LLC, an indirect subsidiary of CCMH. CCOH's Class A common stock is anticipated to go "Ex" the dividend of \$0.4865 per share beginning on August 12, 2014, reflecting the payment of the dividend. Following satisfaction of the demand, the balance outstanding under the Due from CCU Note was reduced by \$175 million. As of June 30, 2014, the outstanding balance of the Due from CCU Note was \$950.2 million.
